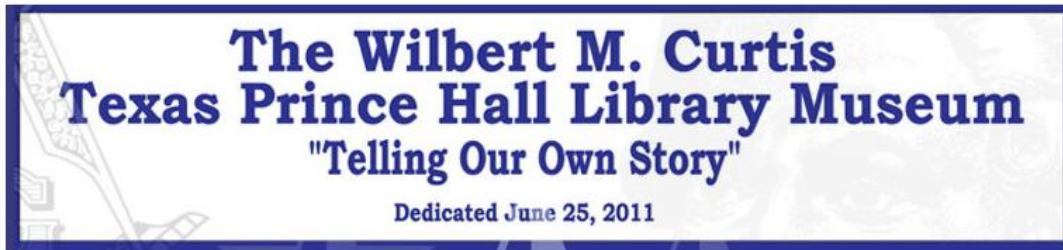


## **To: Prospective Contributors**

**SUBJ: 2014 Wilbert M. Curtis Texas Prince Hall Library Museum Pledge Program**

**WMCTPHLM Gold, Silver, and Bronze Pledge Program:** A program which seeks 300 members from the public to **voluntarily** pledge \$50,000 to support the operations, maintenance and enhancements of the Library Museum. The following pledge amounts would be limited to the first 100 individuals or organizations to sign up for each of the following levels:

Gold:      \$250 x 100 = \$25,000  
Silver:     \$150 x 100 = \$15,000  
Bronze:    \$100 x 100 = \$10,000  
            **Total : \$50,000**

The members who pledge would be allowed to pay in advance or over a 3-month period beginning in August 20, 2014 and ending October 20, 2014. This will allow persons of varies income levels to participate. The following is the minimum monthly payment for each level:

Gold:      \$83.34 x 3 = \$250.02  
Silver:     \$50.00 x 3 = \$150.00  
Bronze:    \$33.34 x 4 = \$100.02

The 300 members who successfully pay their pledges by October 20, 2014 will have their names, to include the Organization they wish to represent, on a nameplate which will be attached to a plaque representing the level they pledged for. The three plaques are to be permanently displayed in the Library Museum and will be unveiled during the 2014 Mid-Winter Session. Additionally, all 300 members will have their name published in The Texas Prince Hall Freemason, and receive a Library Museum lapel pin.

All payments will be made by check, money order or PayPal. Checks and money orders will be made out to the Prince Hall Charitable Foundation, which is a **501(c)(3)** non-profit corporation and, therefore, contributions are tax deductible to individuals, companies and organizations who make their check payable to the Foundation and mailed to Library Museum Committee, 622 Artisan Way, San Antonio, TX 78260. The pledge roster caps out at 100 members each for the three pledge levels. A stand-by roster will be established once a level is at capacity in case circumstances arise where a member cannot fulfill the pledge. No pledges will be refunded.
